Parent Request to Visit and Observe a Class

Davis School District

<u>Utah Code 53G-6-803</u> requires a school to "reasonably accommodate the request of a student's parent to visit and observe any class the student attends." Parents wishing to observe their student's class must make an appointment with the principal and set a date mutually agreeable to both parent and principal before coming to the school to observe a class. Multiple or frequent requests will be accommodated as the principal decides it is reasonable and would not otherwise disrupt classroom instruction.

During an accommodated parent observation, a parent may not take photos or record audio or video without express prior permission from the principal. Visiting parents may not disrupt instruction during the visit. If parents would like to discuss what they observed, they should set an appointment with the principal.

Failure to observe the requirements outlined above could lead to removal from the premises and/or exclusion from future visits to the school.
